CDIA at work

As of May 2012, CDIA has approved applications from 44 cities in 13 countries with a numbers of others under consideration. To date, these interventions have utilized US\$ 14.8 million of CDIA Technical Assistance funding along with US\$ 3.5 million in counterpart contributions.

These interventions are estimated to facilitate approximately US\$ 6.5 billion in strategic urban infrastructure investments. Emphasis is placed on assisting cities to bring in downstream financing through various international and domestic source.

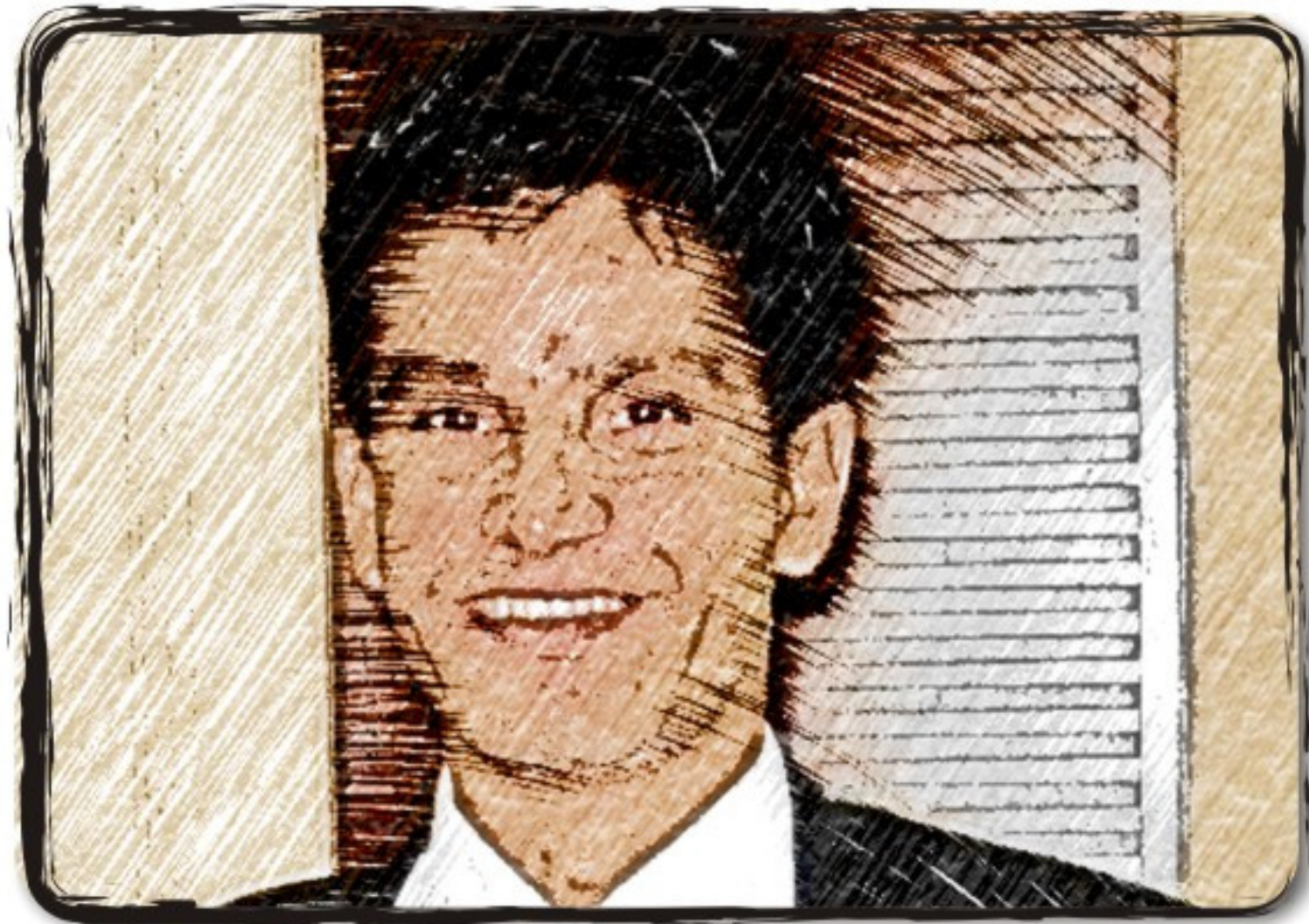

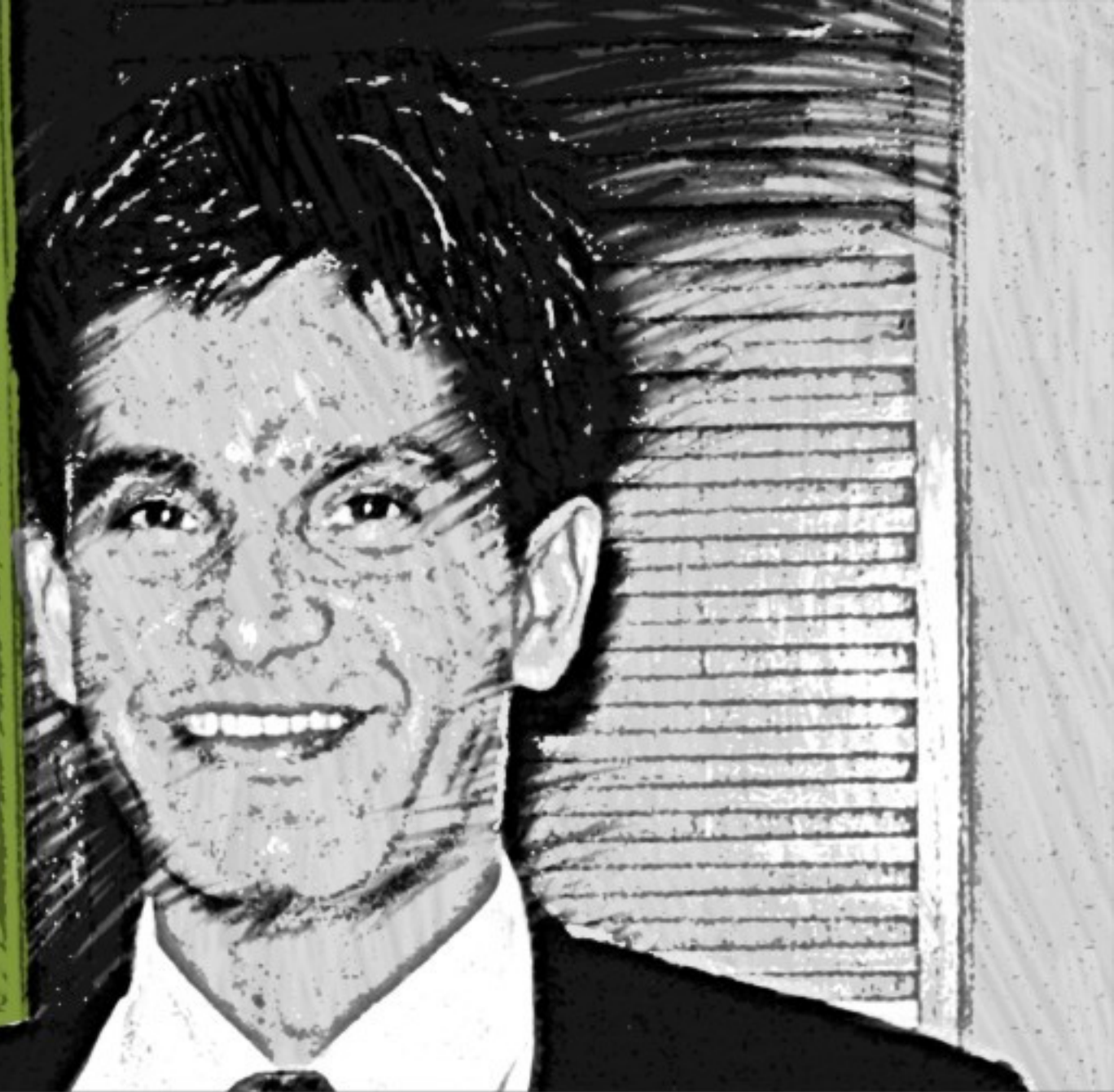

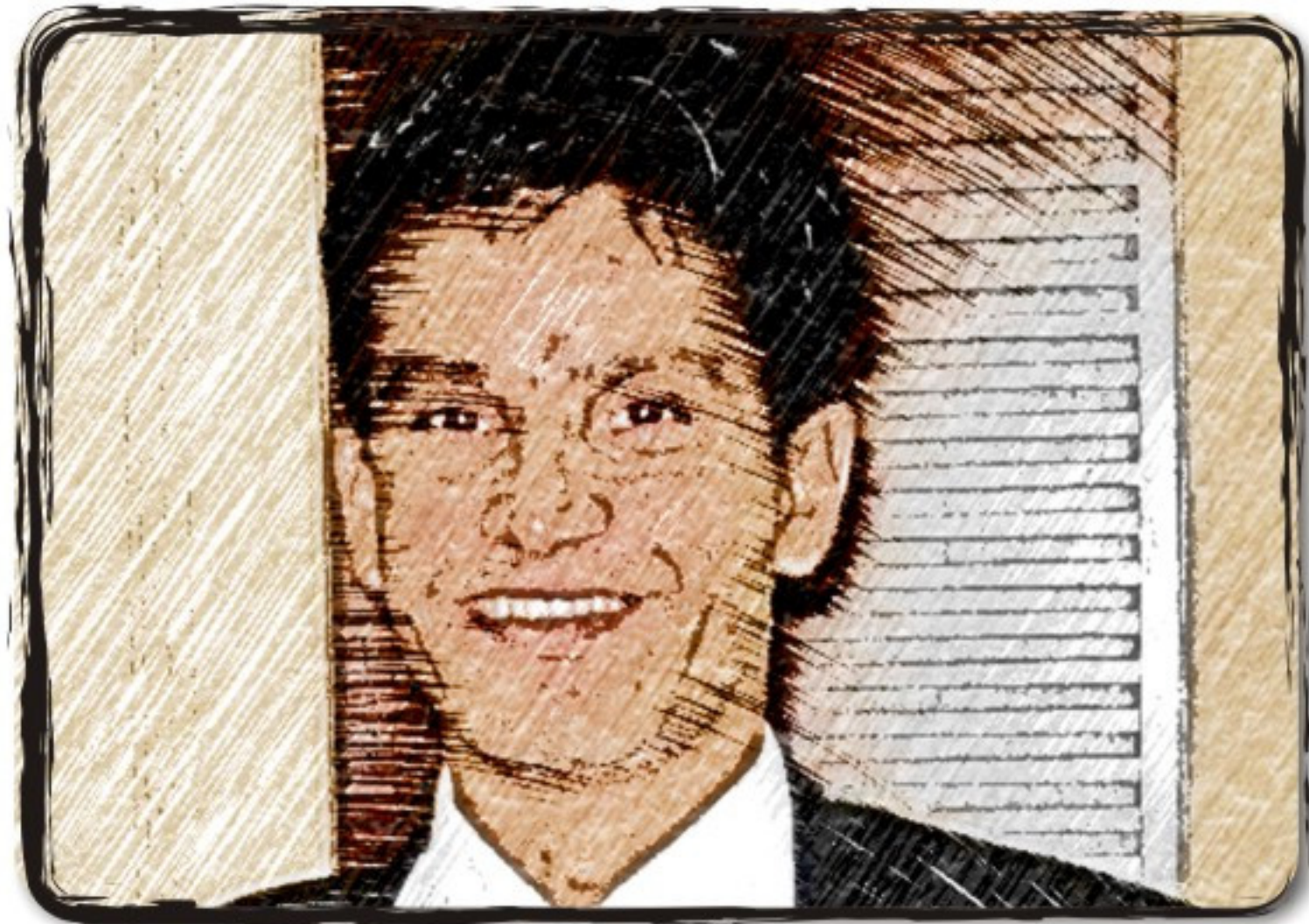
